

## Points in Common with 2015 Proposals

The main concept of our proposals contained in the “2015 Japanese Business in China White Paper” is to secure “non-discrimination.”

Most of the proposals are classified into the following three categories:

### 1. Improvement of the modern market system

In order to build a market mechanism ensuring orderly competition, we propose abolishing or reviewing various regulations that impede fair competition, and further reform of the system to protect intellectual property rights.

### 2. Transformation of government functions

In order to build a government that is ruled by law and that is more service intensive, we propose simplifying and speeding up administrative procedures and abolishing the administrative approval or certificate system.

### 3. Establishment of a new and open economy system

In order to respond to the globalization of the economy, we propose reducing restrictions on the entry of foreign companies in the manufacturing and servicing sectors and in addition, the further application of global standards.
